Landcare is a community-driven, volunteer organisation formed by landholders who want to work together to tackle pressing land management issues and contribute to sustainable landscapes. With their 500+ members, the 11 Landcare groups of the Mornington Peninsula aim to protect and enhance our unique natural environment by promoting responsible care of the land.

### Landcare activities

Examples of Landcare activities include:

- Regional coordinated weed and pest animal control including foxes and cats
- Sustainable agriculture focusing on environmental and economic outcomes
- Field days
- Protecting remnant vegetation
- Revegetation along waterways
- Development of habitat corridors
- Cooperative strategies to address land degradation issues

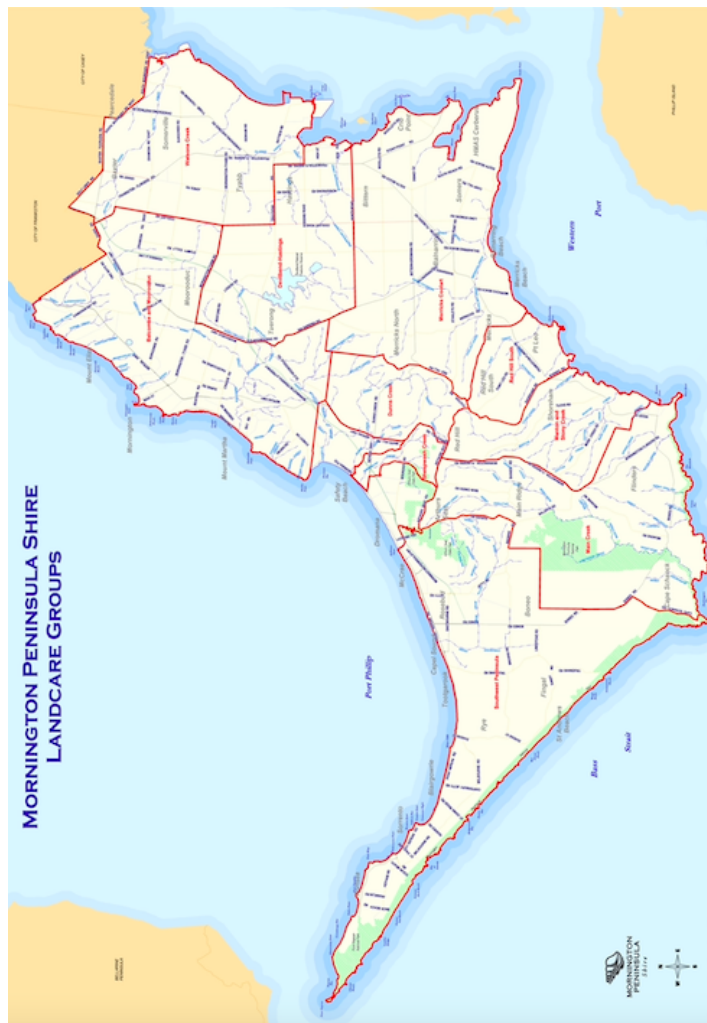
